# LEARN TO SKATE

The Kraken Learn to Skate program is designed to welcome students with no prior ice skating or hockey experience to the rink environment. This 8-week program will focus on basic skating concepts so that students may learn to improve their balance and coordination on the ice while learning how to skate.



# LEARN TO PLAY

After completing the Learn to Skate Program, students will join the Kraken Learn to Play program where they will be introduced to basic hockey skills such as shooting, passing, and stickhandling, while continuing to develop their skating skills. Students will begin to participate in small-area games as they continue their overall development into hockey players.



## EMERALD EDGE

Emerald Edge is our bridge program for skaters progressing from Learn to Skate and advancing into Figure Skating. We utilize U.S. Figure Skating's Aspire Program while adding our own Kraken energy and atmosphere. Skaters will work with our group of professional coaches to learn and develop skills including transitions, spins, jumps and more!



## **JR SQUID**

In house developmental program for 5-9 year olds to prepare for Jr Kraken league play. Players will be grouped based on age and practice twice a week (weeknight + weekend). There are three options to

- choose from: Full season (Sept-Mar)
  - 1/2 season Fall 2022 (Sept-Dec)
  - 1/2 season Winter 2023 (Jan-Mar)



#### **JR KRAKEN**

Competitive play for 8U, 10U, 12U and 14U experienced players as part of the Metropolitan Hockey League. Players will be assigned to an appropriate team based on skill level and age.

- Season: Mid-September to mid-March
- · Practices: Twice a week on weekdays after-school at Kraken Community Iceplex.



#### **CAMPS & CLINICS**

Camps will offer unique, fresh, and fun training opportunities. Participants will have the chance to try new techniques, hone existing skills, meet new kids, and learn from our highly qualified instructors.



All new participants to Kraken Community Iceplex must start with a Learn to Skate class before progressing on to other programs.
