



# KSA SESSION RULES & POLICIES

## Freestyle & Public Sessions

*By participating, all skaters, coaches, parents, and guests agree to these rules.*

### On the Ice

---

**Skate safely.** Choose the right session for your skill level. Management may remove a skater if needed.

**Follow the right-of-way map.** Use designated jump and spin zones. If you leave the standard travel pattern, you're responsible for avoiding collisions.

**Keep the entrance clear.** The ice door must stay shut and unblocked at all times.

**Check in before leaving.** Skaters – tell your coach before stepping off the ice during a freestyle session.

### Audio & Devices

---

**No personal headphones while skating.** Headphones, earbuds, or similar devices are not allowed on ice.

**No filming while skating.** Skater smartphones, GoPros, and cameras are not permitted on ice without permission. Coaches are allowed to video for teaching and testing purposes.

**Recording & Parent Involvement.** Record only your own skater. Video review in the lobby only — not on ice or through the glass. Parents may not participate in lessons in any capacity.

**Coach speakers – keep it moderate.** Coaches may use handheld speakers, but volume must stay at or below the overhead system and not disturb others.

### Music

---

**Overhead music follows a set order.** Rink music plays through the rink system only, in the scheduled order.

**Lyrics must be family-friendly.** Any music heard by the public – overhead or from a coach's speaker – must be appropriate for all ages.

### Coaches

---

**Approved coaches only.** Only coaches who have signed the Private Ice-Skating Coach Facility Use Agreement may provide instruction on ice.

**Keep conversations off-ice.** Non-coaching conversations with parents should happen in the lobby or off-ice areas to avoid distracting others.

**Group size limit.** Coaches may not organize or teach a group of more than 4 skaters without management permission. Must not distract/impede the freestyle session.

**Represent KSA positively.** Coaches are expected to support the rink's programs, promote USFS and USA Hockey, and encourage skater participation in events and activities.]

### General Conduct

**Follow all governing body rules.** All participants must comply with Venue Rules, USFS Skate Safe, US Center for SafeSport, and USA Hockey guidelines at all times.

**Violations:** Violating these rules may result in removal from the ice, suspension from sessions, or other consequences as determined by management. *Questions? Speak to rink management.*
